LTT event for Teachers in Naples, 24-29.09.2018.

Objectives:

- Taking part in lectures and workshops on teaching students various life skills, in order
 to be able to instruct their pupils on the basics of healthy nutrition, food preparation,
 career guidance (helping them with their further educational choices) and home
 economics.
- After the event, teachers will be able create lesson plans on those subjects that will be included in the school curricula and serve as guidance for their peers at partner organizations when it comes to teaching those topics.
- Getting to know Italian culture and history.

In the last week of September, 8 teachers from Greece, Lithuania, Poland, Slovakia, as well as teachers from hosting school in Italy, took part in a 3rd Learning/Teaching/Training Event of the Erasmus+ Project "Essential Life Skills" in Afragola, Italy.

After welcome ceremony held in the hosting school, IstitutoTecnicoStatale "Carlo Alberto Dalla Chiesa", were everyone was welcomed by the head teacher of the school, Mr V. Montesano, and the mayor of Afragola, Mr. Claudio Grillo, teachers spent the afternoon and next days participating in a series of lectures and workshops on:

- 1) How to help students' self-development (particularly in job-searching area, preparing for a job interview, writing a CV, etc.). Teachers learnt how make Introduction to Entrepreneurship lessons more interesting and understandable for students, how to fully engage them in the process of learning and teaching. The workshop was led by prof. Lucia Russo, a professional, Gloscat University lecturer and secondary school teacher.
- 2) Home economics, to help teachers prepare for their lessons and make them more engaging through the use of modern technologies (like mobile apps). All the participants learnt to create their own mobile apps step by step so that later, at their own schools they would be able to teach their students home economics by making them create their own mobile apps and at the same time making lessons more fun and modern. Workshops were led by Valeria Martuscelli, a Computer Science teacher with a diploma in Scientific Studies, a graduate of Mathematics to the University of Salerno and by Irene Gelsomino, a teacher and lecturer certificated with CERT-LIM Interactive Teacher Certificate by AICA (Italian Association for Information Technology and Automatic Calculation) in 2013.
- 3) The topics of healthy nutrition teachers got to know and practice various teaching methods in the topic of healthy nutrition, like Jigsaw, Hot Potato, etc. The workshop was led by Irene Gelsomino, an author of a project "Keeping Healthy" for SMART EDUcation&TECHnology days at CittàdellaScienza (Naples); CLIL teacher after an intense course at the Orientale University of Naples actively involved in projects about a healthy nutrition, addictions, eating disorders, importance of being healthy with a focus on prevention and wellness, etc.

All the participants of this LTT event had also chance to get to know Italian history and culture better by taking part in a guided tour of Naples, visiting two coastal towns: Amalfi and Positano, or impressive ancient ruins of Pompeii.
